45 years ago on May 25th, 1977, sci-fi fandom — and indeed many other facets of fandom including comic books, toy collecting, CosPlay (which didn't even have a proper name yet), and more — changed forever. George Lucas' STAR WARS debuted, and no one would look at the many facets of fandom (and life in general) in the same way again.

STAR WARS changed the face of reality... it captured the imaginations of those who followed sci-fi as well as average moviegoers who had never seen its like before (or had they?). It changed how we went to the movies, the age of the blockbuster was upon us in full force (no pun intended), launched two years earlier by Lucas' friend and fellow filmmaker Steven Spielberg with his adaptation of Peter Benchley's JAWS. And now this month, it feels like STAR WARS has returned once again with the highly anticipated new Disney+ series, OBI-WAN KENOBI. This new series tells the story of Obi-Wan as he guarded the life of young Luke Skywalker, deposited with his Aunt Beru and Uncle Owen on Tatooine. The series is set roughly a decade before A NEW HOPE, and we can expect some exciting moments

Exploring the anguish of immigration and the lasting effects that displacement has on a child and her family, Thi MONTH Bui documents the story of her family's daring escape after the fall of South Vietnam in the 1970s, and the difficulties they faced building new lives for themselves. At the heart of Bui's story is a universal struggle: While adjusting to life as a first-time mother, she ultimately discovers what it means to be a parent - the endless sacrifices, the unnoticed gestures, and the depths of unspoken love. Despite how impossible it seems to take on the simultaneous roles of both parent and child, Bui pushes through. With haunting, poetic writing and breathtaking art, she examines the strength of family, the importance of identity, and the meaning of home. (STL229799) (C: 0-1-0)
